**NOTICE CONCERNING THE
2020-2021 SEMESTER 1 EXAMINATIONS (« COMPOS »)**

1. The school will provide all necessary paper for the exams, from S5 to S6. Pupils cannot remove any paper used during the exam from the examination room. Exam answers must be written in black or blue ink. No correction fluid (for example "Tipp-Ex"), no erasable ink allowed.
2. Unauthorised materials are not allowed in the examination room. Pupils ignoring this rule risk having their examination declared void. Bags and coats must be left outside the examination room (or against the front wall of the examination room). Pupils may not go to their bags or coats during an examination. No items are allowed on the floor by your desk. Neither mobile phones nor headphones nor smartwatches are allowed in the examination room. In addition, for S6 pupils no watches are allowed in line with the Bacca-laureate regulations.
3. No communication with other pupils is permitted during an examination. Pupils are neither allowed to borrow items or papers from other pupils nor to disturb other pupils in any way during an examination. Any questions should be directed to the invigilators.
Any attempt at fraud will be punished by a score of 0. In addition, the administration has the right to consider other measures.
4. **Pupils may not leave the examination room nor present their exam answer paper during the first period of an examination.**
Pupils who finish before the exam's end time may present their answer paper to the invigilator.

For S6 pupils:

- at the end of their exams, pupils must leave the building immediately and not linger or wait by the toilets.
 - pupils must stop writing once an examination has been declared finished by the invigilators.
 - during the final 10 minutes of an exam pupils must remain at their desks until their script is collected by an invigilator. Pupils must not go to the invigilators' desk.
5. S5 pupils may not go to the toilet for the first two periods of an examination, excluding here any pupils who may have special permission for this purpose. S6 pupils may go to the toilet 1 period after the start of the examination, after having been registered on the ad hoc register.
 6. For S5 pupils: The only drink permitted in the examination is water in a plastic bottle. Cans and glass bottles are not allowed. Eating is not allowed during an examination. If a student needs for health reasons to consume food during the exam, this must be placed on his/her desk; pupils in this situation may momentarily remove their mask to eat and replace it immediately. Students should not disturb other candidates by opening packets. Only small snacks (like candy or muesli bars, dry fruits, and similar) are allowed; invigilators may take some food items away if they are not considered as appropriate.

For S6 pupils: The only drink permitted in the examination is water in a plastic bottle. Cans and glass bottles are not allowed. If a student needs to consume food during the exam, this must be placed on his/her desk and pupils may momentarily remove their mask to eat and replace it immediately. Students should not disturb other candidates by opening packets. Only small snacks (like candy or muesli bars, dry fruits, and similar) are allowed; invigilators may take some food items away if they are not considered as appropriate.

7. For S5 pupils, according to the syllabus and the decisions of the Board of Governors only **a non-graphing and non-programmable scientific calculator is permitted** and for S6 pupils the calculator *TI-Nspire CX CAS with software version 4.5.X.X. or higher* can be used. These two tools are allowed during mathematics, biology, chemistry, geography, physics and economics examinations.
Pupils must bring their own calculator, fully charged. A calculator check will be made before the exam. **Before the check the calculator cannot be in test-mode.** Only after the check, and following the teacher instructions, pupils will put the calculator in test-mode. **Pupils cannot share calculators.**

8. Pupils must indicate at the top of each exam page:
- their family name and first name.
 - their class
 - the course
 - the name of the course teacher
9. Pupils are responsible for arriving on time; **additional time will not be given for late-comers**. For S6, late comers are admitted subject to the Director's approval. For S5, late comers have to report to the educational advisers office (B001), and admission to the exam will be subject to Management's decision.
10. When a pupil is absent due to illness, he/she must hand in a medical certificate to the educational adviser of the year at the very latest the following day. He/she will be informed by the educational adviser regarding the substitute examination(s) organised for him/her. The substitute examinations will normally be organised during the first week of January 2021.
- In case of unjustified absence, the test mark will be a zero.**
