- ▶ And learn some basic steps 😊





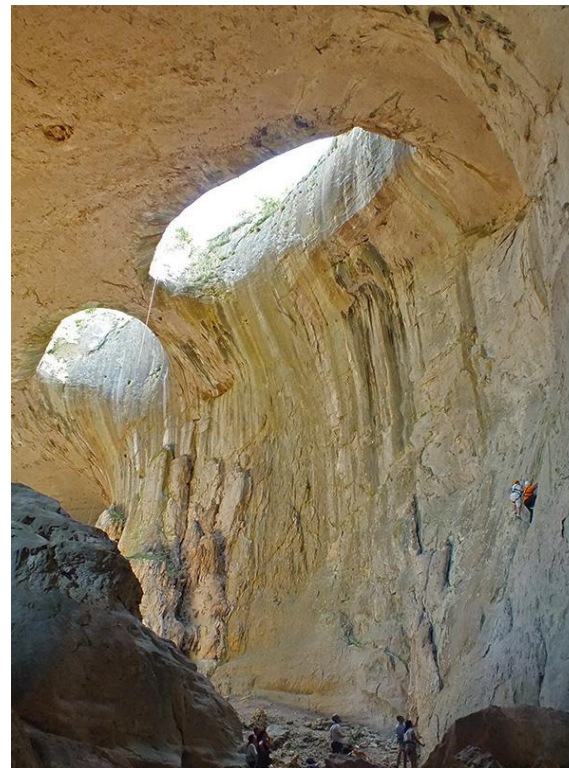
Day 3 - Adventure Day
