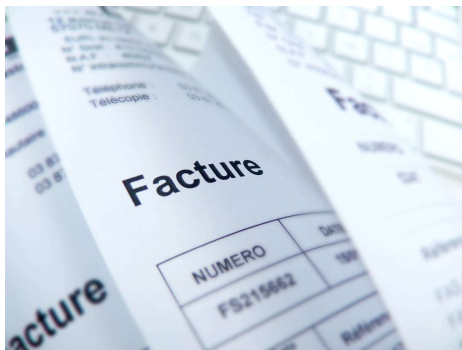

# PRICE AND INVOICE



## PRICE OF S6 TRIPS

**1080€**

- If by plane - CO<sub>2</sub> compensation included
- Invoice from the school, 1 time payment (an invoice will be sent to you) in January.
- Balance refund after the trip  
*(If the settlement exceeds a price of more than 50 euros. Otherwise (no overrun) the money collected will go to a solidarity fund.*
- Cost of Luxembourg trip will be communicated

# FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- The Luxembourg 1 Parents' Association (APEEEL1) aims to help families who are in need of assistance towards the payment of school trip expenses.
- APEEEL1 has its own social fund, separate from that of the school.

- The level of the contribution will be decided according to the net monthly household income, and will also take into account family composition and any other current circumstances that the family chooses to share with APEEEL1.



## WHAT IF A STUDENT WITHDRAWS FROM THE TRIP?

- We have cancellation insurance, which only covers cases of illness **supported by a medical certificate** (and provided that the illness was not known before the trip was booked and that the application is accepted by the insurance company).

- minimum and maximum numbers of participants per trips have to be respected (mostly 30/35)

- Around 30/35 students in 9 destinations (excluding Luxembourg)
- Please give **only one identity reference**: ID or Passport (not both)

- **PARENTAL AUTHORISATION:** A link will be sent to you in Announcement (parents' mail) Please read it and fill it in.

  - **Authorisation to leave the country (minors)**
  - **The travel rules (to sign)**
  - **A medical form to cover any allergies, illnesses, etc.**

## AUTHORISATION TO LEAVE THE TERRITORY

- For non-Luxembourg residents (Germany, Belgium)
  - Some local councils of your own city provide these (please enquire).
  - If applicable: an official document from the school will be sent to you
  - Please fill it in and **come in person (one of the parents) to have it stamped at the secondary school office**



# AUTHORISATION TO LEAVE THE TERRITORY

- Students who are of legal age do not need one.
- Dates: 1 April to 30 May
- Under the supervision of: EUROPEAN SCHOOL LUX 1
- **Authorisations can be made immediately and submitted to Mr PETIT (Room T005) no later than the week before the Christmas holidays.**
