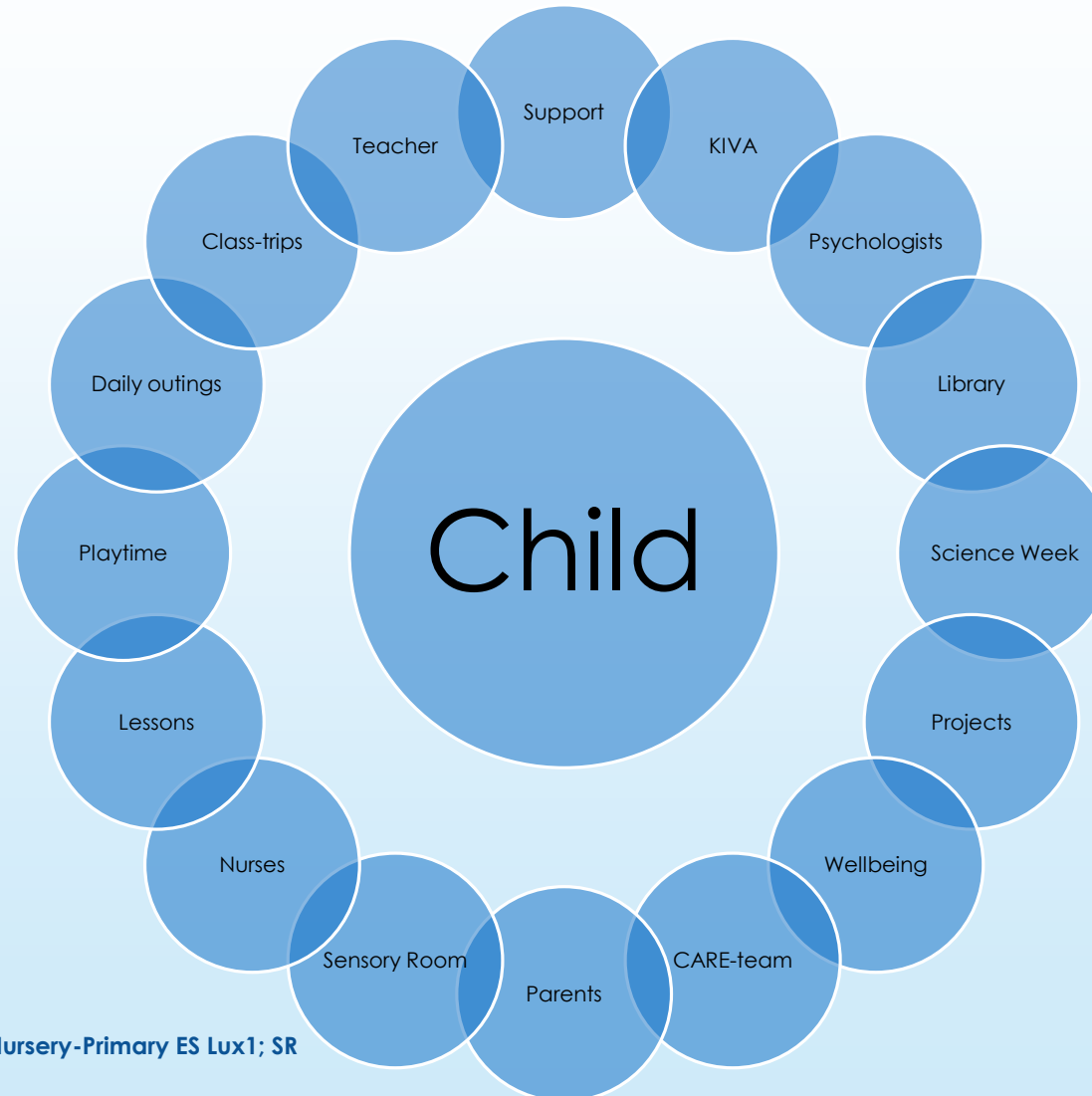


Mission of the European School

KiVa

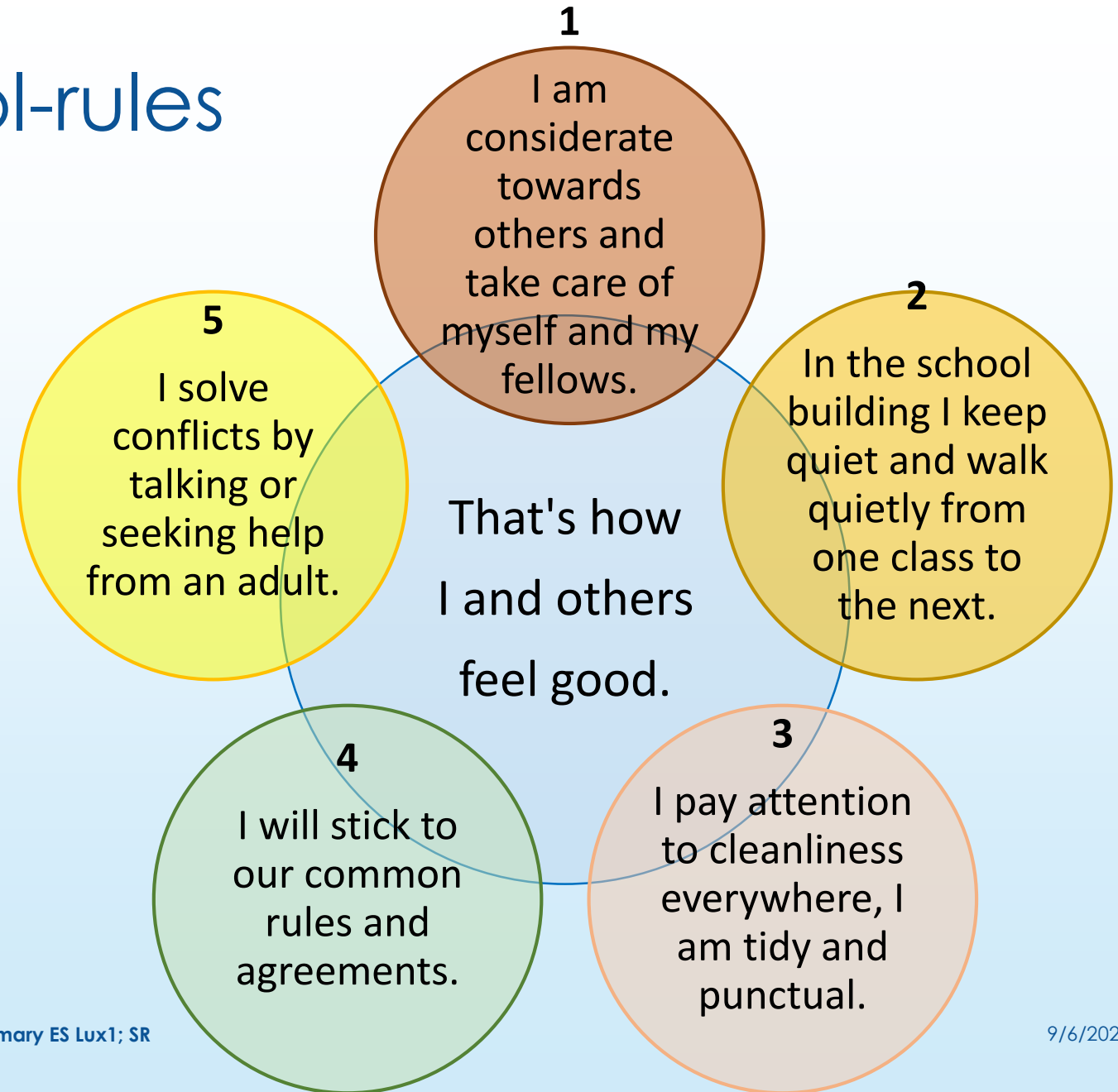
Anti-bullying program

- ▶ KiVa includes both universal and indicated actions.
- ▶ The universal actions, such as Kiva curriculum (student lessons) are directed at all students and focus mainly on preventing bullying.
- ▶ The indicated actions (targeted interventions by the Kiva team members) are to be used when a bullying case has emerged.
- ▶ They are targeted specifically to the children and adolescents who have been involved in bullying as perpetrators or victims, as well as to several classmates who are challenged to support the victim; the aim is to put an end to bullying.

Disciplinary Measures for Students PRI

General Rules of the European Schools. 2014-03-D-14-en-11
CHAPTER VI/ Discipline Articles 40, 41, 42, 43

Extract on article 42 b)

- 1. Reprimand
- 2. Extra work
- 3. Detention (during playtime)
- 4. Warning and/or sanction by the Director
- 5. Warning and/or sanction by the Director on a proposal from the Discipline Council
- 6. Temporary exclusion from the school - by the Director, for a maximum of three working days...

- 7. Exclusion from one or more school trips...
- 8. Expulsion from the school decided by the Director on a proposal from the Discipline Council

Extract on article 42 c)

- c) Disciplinary measures in the primary cycle shall be of the same nature, except that expulsion shall not be possible...
