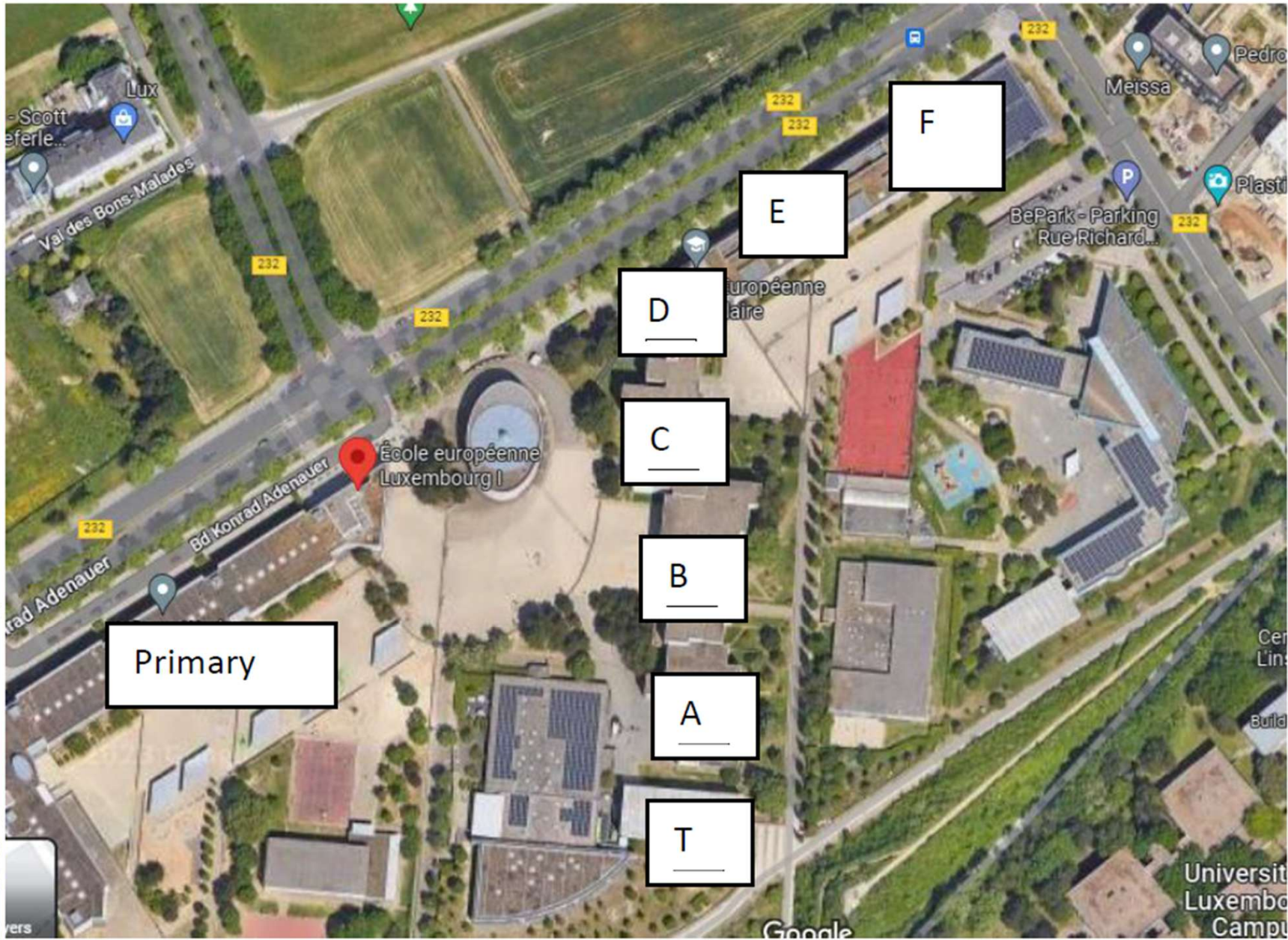



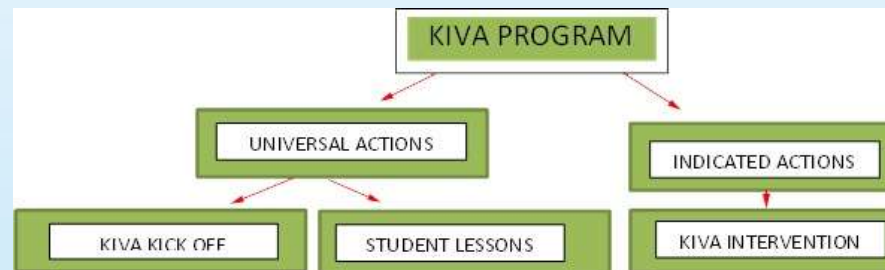

- ▶ Two or more students involved in a dispute meet in a private, safe and confidential setting to work out problems with the assistance of two trained student mediators.
- ▶ After a certified training
- ▶ Violence prevention

- ▶ innovative school-based anti-bullying program which has been developed at the University of Turku in Finland

- ▶ Kiva includes both universal and indicated actions



The class teacher

- First in line to pass and receive information
- Key person for students ('AAA hour')




Homework time per level

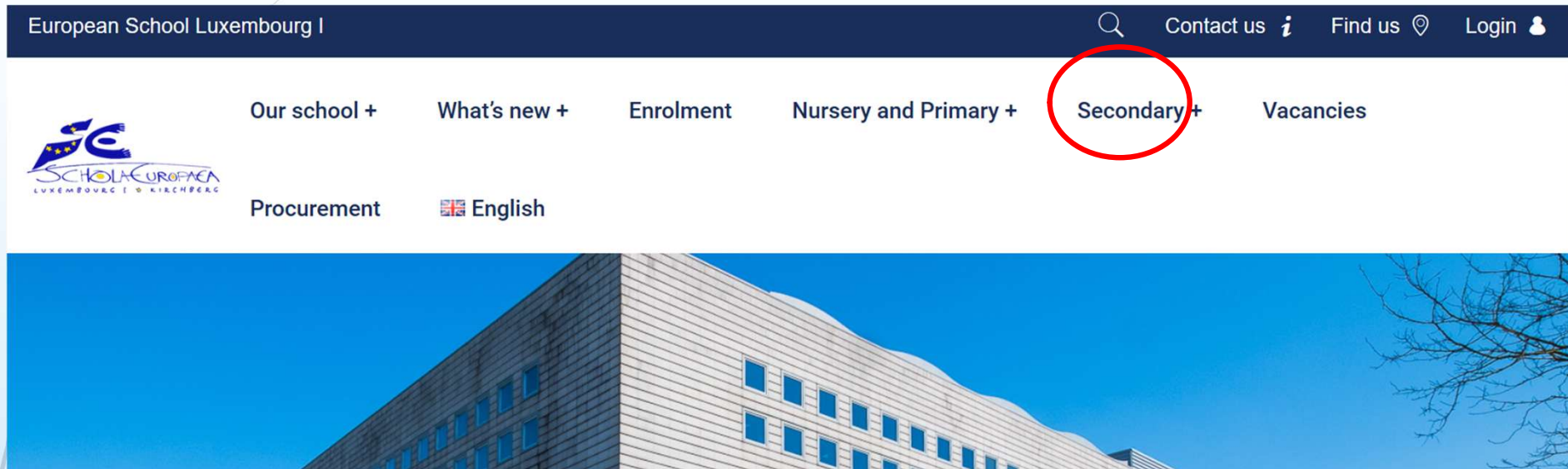

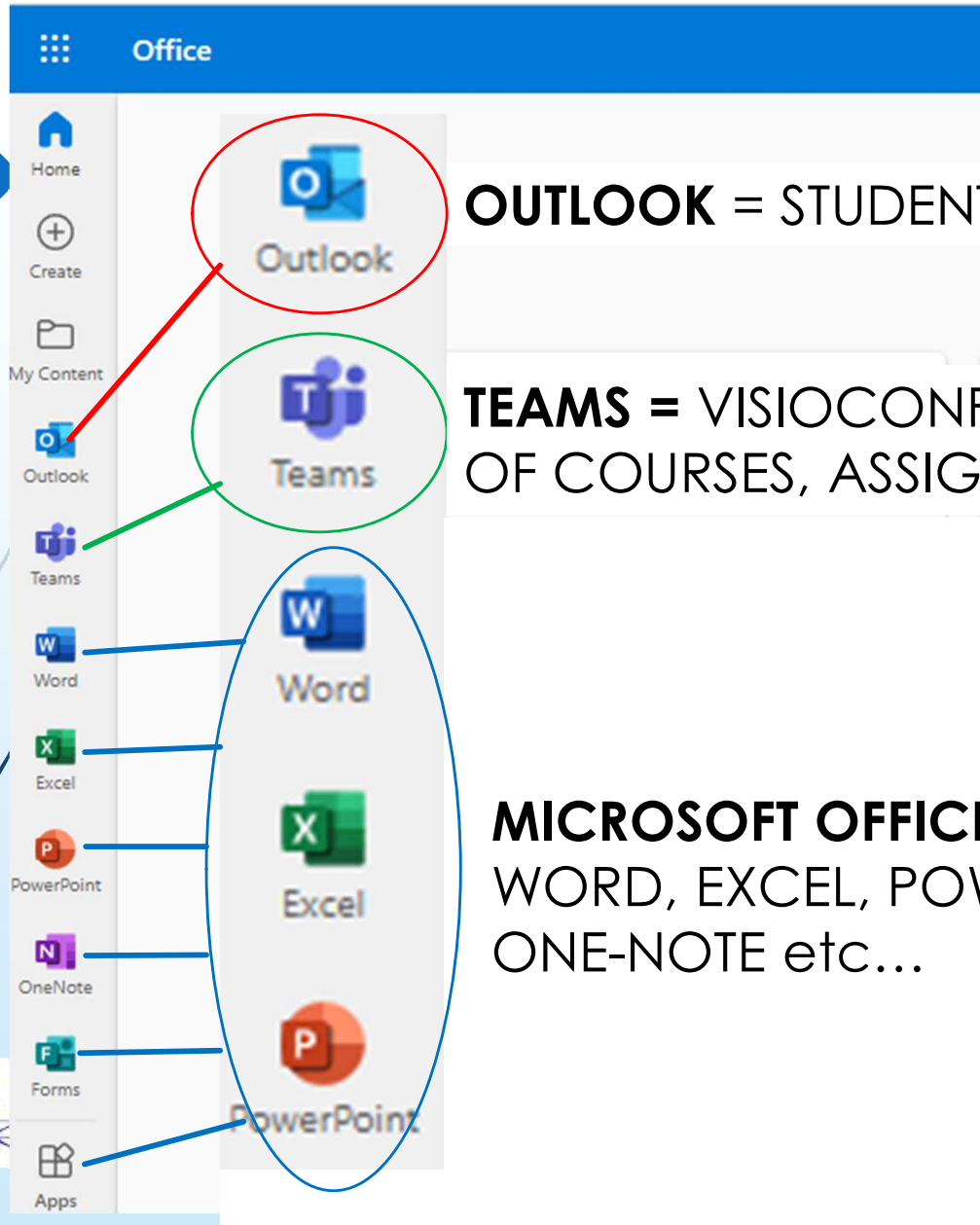
